



Natural Helpers Coordinator

Per Diem position coordinating the Natural Helpers prevention program in a minimum of 9 participating schools statewide; serving as liaison between program and adult facilitators. This is a prevention and intervention program that taps into the “natural” network of peers helping peers. The position researches, develops and analyzes evaluation tools for the program and maintains web-based media for the program.

The majority of the work is done between August and November, and February through April.

Responsibilities include:

Plan, coordinate, facilitate four overnight fall retreats, organize the spring conference and various meetings. Facilitate efforts to meet each school’s prevention goals; update Natural Helper program material and conduct program site visits.

Requirements include:

Bachelor’s degree in social services or related field; 3-5 years prevention and/or treatment experience; experience with adolescents; ability to travel throughout the state; excellent verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills; computer literacy.
