



Project SUCCESS Prevention Specialist

Project SUCCESS (Schools Using Coordinated Community Efforts to Strengthen Students) is a one-year, school-based adolescent substance abuse prevention and early intervention program at Kennebunk High School.

This is a per diem position with the majority of the work being done between September and November, and January and March, with the remainder of time spent providing one-on-one counseling/education to a small caseload of students.

Development, Coordination, and Implementation of five Project SUCCESS program components:

- ❖ Prevention Education Series: Implementation of 45-90 minute classroom education curriculum.
- ❖ Individual and Group Counseling: Time-limited individual and/or group counseling sessions at school to small caseload of students following participation in the Prevention Education Series.
- ❖ School-Wide Awareness and Outreach Activities: Help students develop and implement a substance-related prevention education and/or intervention plan.
- ❖ Parent Program: Develop parent workshops in collaboration with school officials.
- ❖ Referral: Assess for and ensure referral to other services for students who require additional services.
- ❖ Train and supervise extern and intern to assist in provision of each component.
- ❖ All other duties as assigned.

Required Education/Training/Skills Needed for Position:

- ❖ Bachelor's degree or 5 years experience in social services or a related field
- ❖ Minimum of LADC, LCPC-C, LMSW, required
- ❖ 3-5 years of prevention and/or treatment experience
- ❖ Experience with adolescents necessary
- ❖ Familiarity with substance abuse prevention required
- ❖ Effective public speaking skills
- ❖ Excellent verbal, written, and interpersonal communication skills
- ❖ Excellent critical thinking, organizational and time management skills
- ❖ Excellent independent work and self-management skills.
- ❖ Demonstrated ability to work with diverse systems
- ❖ Computer literacy with standard business applications
